## **West Coast Port Congestion and Delays**

According to trade industry publication the Journal of Commerce

congestion at the ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach grew worse over the weekend, with no relief in sight as late peak-season container volumes descend on the largest U.S. port complex.

"The vessels keep arriving and the trucks keep arriving," said John Cushing, president of PierPass Inc., which manages the extended gates



program for the 13 container terminals in the port complex.

Cushing said terminal operators are spending millions of dollars and taking extraordinary steps, including running very costly "hoot owl" shifts from 3 a.m. to 8 a.m. to relieve congestion in their container yards. But the cargo keeps building up at the terminals. According to the individual ports, combined container throughput in 2014 through August at the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach are 4.5 percent higher than the same period in 2013.

As a reminder to Cargo Services customers, we are advising clients to avoid Los Angeles/Long Beach by utilizing Seattle/Tacoma and Prince Rupert. Also Vancouver is slowly clearing out congestion, so container dwell days are declining to 3 to 5 days making this port a good option.

This congestion is the ripple effect of brutal winter weather in the eastern half of the continent, congestion and rail car shortages on the rail networks, truck and driver shortages and chassis dislocations that are
